- IF YOU HAVE NON-BINARY PARTICIPANTS AND ARE TRAVELLING TO AWAY GAMES, MAKE SURE YOU'RE AWARE OF THE FACILITIES AVAILABLE AT THE CLUB YOU'RE VISITING
- USE **GENDER NEUTRAL LANGUAGE.** REFER TO PARTICIPANTS AS THEY/THEM UNTIL YOU ARE CONFIDENT OF SOMEONE'S PRONOUNS
- IF YOU MAKE A MISTAKE, CORRECT YOURSELF & MOVE ON
